To inspire an appreciation for cultural achievements and help students develop their own talents.



Ensuring Readiness for Life

To prepare students for a sustainable life with a focus on well-being and community.



Building Readiness for Work

To equip students with the confidence and skills needed for a dynamic work landscape.

Increase Focus on Practical Life Skills

Calls for more support for struggling/neurodiverse students and better classroom management.



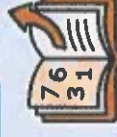
