**In S5**, you must study **5 subjects**; the subjects you choose should ideally be subjects you are currently studying in S4 to allow for progression in your learning but can also be new options. You will also have half the session with 1 period of PE and the other half RMPS and 1 period of PSE each week.

In S6, you must ensure your subject choices meet the new points requirements and equal 24:

- Advanced Higher = 7 Points
- Higher = 6 Points
- National 4/5 = 4 Points
- NPA / SCQF Level 5/6 = 4 Points

S6 will also have the choice of 1 period of PE or RMPS, 1 period of PSE and may potentially have some study periods. Volunteering opportunities will be available and students can be timetabled to support an S1-3 class in a subject in which they are competent.

All S5/6 students will have a coursing meeting with their guidance teacher or a member of SMT where they will receive support and advice to complete your subject choices.

Students in the Senior Phase are increasingly benefiting from undertaking a range of qualifications and awards that are delivered by the school staff and our partners. For some students this means that for part of their 'school week' they may be learning off campus or remotely via partnerships such as the School College Partnership (SCP) or Foundation Apprenticeship (FA). This is predominantly on a Tuesday and Thursday afternoon and a Monday and Wednesday afternoon. Further information on this can be found by clicking on the link below.
