### **TRANSPORT ARRANGEMENT FOR EDINBURGH COLLEGE PUPILS TUESDAY/THURSDAY AFTERNOONS**

Pupils travelling to and from Edinburgh College please make sure you are aware of the following arrangements for transport;

#### **Sighthill Campus**

You will be excused from class at 12:05 to allow time for eating your packed lunch before you leave for your bus and to get changed if you wish. You must ensure you leave enough time to sign out at the office and make your way to the collection point. A private bus will collect you from the front of the school at 12:25. This will be a 30 seater bus shared with students going to Granton Campus. Sighthill will be dropped off first, then Granton.

**Please note: For the return journey the bus will collect Granton pupils first then will collect from Sighthill.**

#### **Granton Campus**

You will be excused from class at 12:05 to allow time for eating your packed lunch before you leave for your bus/taxi and to get changed if you wish. You must ensure you leave enough time to sign out and make your way to the collection point/bus stop. A private bus will collect you from the front of the school at 12:25. This will be a 30 seater bus shared with students going to Granton Campus. Sighthill will be dropped off first, then Granton.

**Please note: For the return journey the bus will collect Granton pupils first then will collect from Sighthill.**

**Granton pupils MUST be at the collection point agreed with the driver at 16.10 so we can limit the delay in getting to Sighthill.**

#### **Milton Road Campus**

You will be excused from class at 12:05 to allow time for eating your packed lunch before you leave for your taxi and to get changed if you wish. You must ensure you leave enough time to sign out and make your way to the collection point. A Taxi will collect you from the school at 12:30. This taxi will leave at 12:30 sharp and collect 1 Beeslack HS student on the way to Milton Road Campus.
