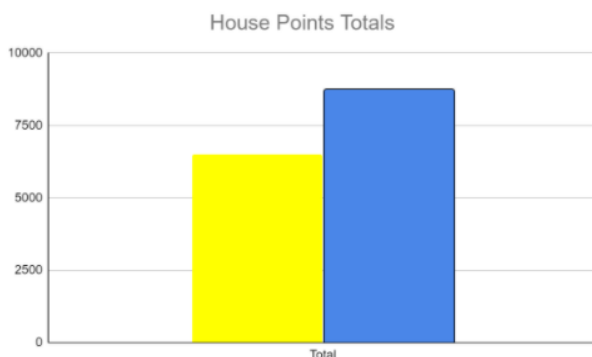


CLERK MAXWELL STORMS AHEAD AFTER WINNING RAG BAG COLLECTION!

PRIDE points are the updated House points system. The points are as follows:
