POSITIVE PSYCHOLOGY - PERMA - What is it?

Positive psychology only developed as a research field about 25 years ago with all previous research into mental health having followed a disease model. Dr Martin Seligman developed this research and came up with the PERMA model. We'll look at this throughout the week.
