SQA EXAMINATIONS - Updated

Please be aware that our SQA exams have now started. Various rooms around the school are being used for exams therefore students should make a conscious effort to move around the building quietly. If there is a 'no entry' sign on a classroom door please follow this instruction. The assembly hall is our main exam room. This means the corridor behind the hall should not be used and will have no entry signs. Under no circumstances should any student be in this corridor or be accessing the stage. **In addition to this, students should only use the main front corridor (which runs from TLC along to the janitors office) if they need to access the office - please use the side stairs and go along the first floor instead). The main stairs should not be used.**
