BIG 5 FOCUS OF THE WEEK

Following the assemblies last week, the focus for this week is showing evidence of learning. Please read the slides shown below to understand what showing evidence of your learning means, what it might look like, and why it is important!

Look out for opportunities to show evidence of your learning this week, and keep your eyes peeled for next week's focus.

- Top Left Slide:** 'What is it?'
 - Showing what you've learned:
 - To yourself
 - To other students
 - To your teacher
- Top Right Slide:** 'What does it look like?'
 - Answering questions in class
 - Asking questions in class
 - Discussing with a partner or a group
 - Talking with your teacher
 - Writing answers to questions
 - Using mini-whiteboards
 - Self-assessment
 - Quizzes
 - Kahoot
 - Etc.
- Bottom Left Slide:** 'Why does it matter?'
 - Your teacher needs to know what you've learned, and what you haven't learned, so that they can plan how to help you
 - If your teacher thinks you've learned something but you haven't, they'll move onto something else and you might fall behind
 - Sometimes you might think you've learned something, but there may be gaps in your understanding that your teacher needs to know about
- Bottom Right Slide:** 'What can I do about it?'
 - Be willing to answer questions when asked
 - Don't be afraid of making mistakes – they're how we all learn!
 - Ask questions – if you're not sure about something, let your teacher know!
