SCHOOL PARLIAMENT UPDATE

After yesterday's Parliament meeting two things were agreed:

1. That as a pilot next term students from S2-S6 will be allowed out of the grounds at breaktime as a trial. Retaining that right will rely on students returning to school on time and no widespread reports of anti-social behaviour or littering in the community. The new S1 will need to remain in school.
2. The doors that lead into the basin area of the girl's BiteSite toilets have been removed to avoid loitering/anti-social behaviour, vaping and truancy. It was agreed that these doors do not affect privacy as the toilets are behind another door. It was also felt a few were spoiling the use of toilets for the majority.
