

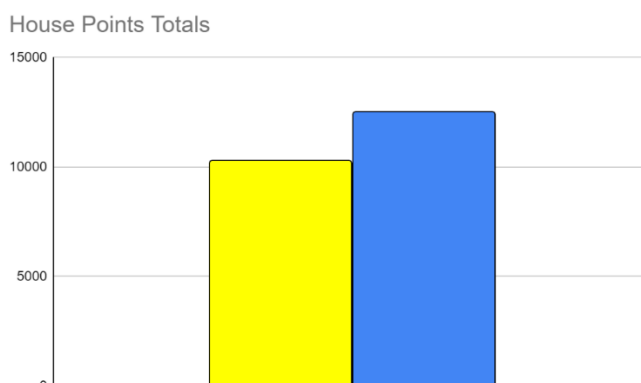


PENICUIK HOUSE POINTS
