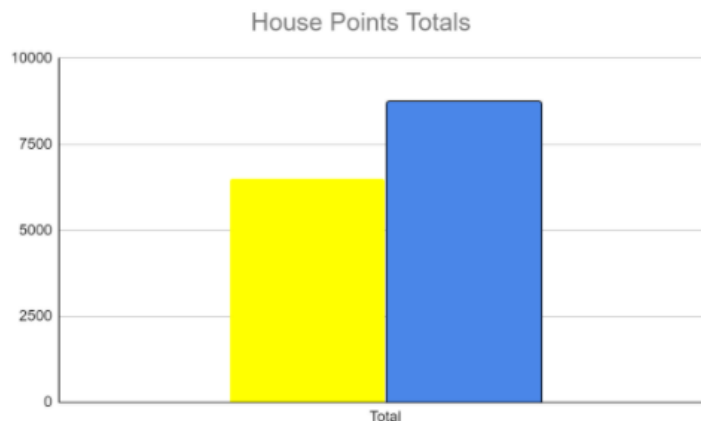


CLERK MAXWELL STORMS AHEAD AFTER WINNING RAG BAG COLLECTION!
